CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. S. Leighton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 6, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Sec. 6 bears S. 47° 52' 48" E. a distance of 3,741.06 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is produced from a drilled well thence pumped into the Reno-Sparks distribution system where it is used within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 5, W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 8, W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 17, Sections 6, 7, 18, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 2, E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 11, E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 14, Sections 1, 12, 13 T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. for municipal and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
