CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a well, pump and stock trough for stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows, Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Sec. 7, T.30N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Sec. 7 bears S. 87° 45' E., a distance of 5180 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.

Name of appropriator Charles B. Evans, Jr. and Peggy D. Evans

Post-office address Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1000 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 30, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

water is diverted by submersible pump from the well through a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipeline to a 2,000 gallon stock trough located within the same legal subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 1000 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
