CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bill DeLong has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Woodcamp Spring through spring, dam and troughs for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows. SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 12, T.36N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of Sec. 7, T.36N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 44° 56' E. a distance of 3,690.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.00334 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle
Period of use from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 15, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is impounded at the spring by an earth dam, 4' wide by 3' high thence conveyed by 2 inch pipe, 12 feet to three troughs 12' x 3' x 1' located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 800 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
