 CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. Chester Young, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Big Smoky Creek (aka Kingston Creek) through gated reservoir, diversion dams and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows, SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 15, T.16N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 15 bears S. 84° 08' E., a distance of 3695.72 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.
