CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. P. Osgood Jr. (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Truckee River through headgate, ditches irrigation for purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14 bears N. 24° 26' E. a distance of 1840.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.30 but not to exceed 28.35 acre feet per season
Period of use, from as decreed to of each year
Date of priority of appropriation as decreed

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
10 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit. This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 21142 which in turn changed the point of diversion and place of use of Claim 498, Truckee River Final Decree Docket in Equity A-3 hence the date of priority of this certificate remains the same as Claim 498 Truckee River Decree.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
