WHEREAS, Donald E. Lewis, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.7N., R.65E., M.D.B. & M. (unsurveyed), or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 31, T.8N., R.66E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 59°17'E., a distance of 20,357 feet, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Water is pumped from the well by a windmill and also by a gasoline engine and pump jack, thence conveyed by 2½-inch lines 65 feet to a tank 20-feet in diameter by 2-feet deep, located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 1,000 head of cattle.


