CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard M. Black, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for commercial and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 18, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Sec. 18 bears N. 16° 31' 28" E., a distance of 986.50 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation	0.50 c.f.s., not to exceed 5.585 million gallons annually
Period of use, from	January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation	August 27, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

water is pumped from a well through a distribution system for commercial and domestic use within a 51-unit trailer park within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 18, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit. It is further issued with the understanding that the total annual duty of water allowed under this certificate and Permit 22679 (Certificate 8051) shall not exceed 5.585 million gallons annually.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
