CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Arthur M. Perkins has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic (recreation park) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 22, T.14S., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 22 bears N. 5° 26' 55" E., a distance of 149.65 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Arthur M. Perkins
Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.25 c.f.s., not to exceed 18.81 acre-feet per year
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 26, 1965

Description of means of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from a drilled well and distributed through pipelines to sprinklers for irrigation and domestic use in a recreational park on 6.27 acres located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
