CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joseph W. Whittle, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through three drilled artesian wells and irrigation system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows. SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 8, T.21N., R.35E., M.D.B.&M. or at three points from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 8 bears S. 89° 10' E. a distance of 1840.0 feet, S. 85° 10' E., a distance of 1620.0 feet, and S. 88° 50' E., a distance of 1590.0 feet. situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
