CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry D. Ott has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Barber Canyon Creek through dam, reservoir and tank truck for mining and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Sec. 23, T.33N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S¹/₄ corner of said Sec. 23 bears S. 38° 45' W. a distance of 820.0 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.429 c.f.s. but not to exceed 310.50 acre feet annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 19, 1969

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is impounded by a small dam thence pumped into a 500 gallon tank truck and conveyed to the places of use within portions of Sections 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 33, 34, and 35, T.33N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M. and sections 3 and 4, T.32N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M. and also used at the point of diversion through a sluice box. The water is used in a placer gold mining operation.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
