CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George D. Duffy has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Limerick Canyon Creek through a diversion dam and pipeline for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 7, T.28N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 7 bears N. 46° 44' E., a distance of 567.06 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.062 c.f.s., not to exceed 3.94 mga
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 16, 1969

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by earthen diversion dam and reservoir through a 4-inch pipeline to a 10,000 gallon storage tank, from which it is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 7, T.28N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
