CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source

through drilled well, pump and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 35, T.38N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 35 bears S. 82° 50' W. a distance of 3,480.0 feet

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John W. Oldham

Post-office address Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from April 1st to September 30th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 22, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is produced from the well thence pumped through 200 feet of 2-inch pipe to a 3' by 30' trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
