CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Creek Spring through spring cleanouts, pipeline and watering troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 18, T.37N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 18 bears N. 23° 52' E., a distance of 1079.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0167 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 15, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by two spring cleanouts through 200 ft. of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch plastic pipe to one 2' x 16" x 100' watering trough, one 16' long by 6' diameter storage tank and a small pond all located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 18, T.37N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for stockwatering of 1500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
