CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donald E. Lewis, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 30, T.6N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 30 bears N. 21° 33' 45" E. a distance of 1,279.10 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.

Name of appropriator, David A. Witts

Post-office address Dallas, Texas

Amount of appropriation 0.067 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.095 mga

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 3, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is pumped from the well into a pressure tank thence conveyed by pipeline to a house, three mobile homes and stock corrals located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
