CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Earl Hill, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring through dam, pipeline and stockwatering tank for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 18, T.18N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 18 bears S. 71° 50' 30" E., a distance of 2199 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 16, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by a small dam through 11,120 feet of 3" plastic pipe to a stockwatering tank located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 29, T.18N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for the stockwatering of 200 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
