CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jack W. Bay has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from un-named spring through collection box, pipeline irrigation (Landscaping) for purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 4 T13N R19E MDB&M or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 4 bears S. 11° 49' 23" E. a distance of 4008.93 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.

Amount of appropriation 0.0033 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.135 mg per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 24, 1965

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected at the spring in a 4' x 4' x 4' collection box thenced conveyed via 100' of 4" and 1080' of 2" pipeline to the property and used for landscaping. The place of use is located within the portion NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4 T13N R19E MDB&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
