CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. J. Vasey (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 32, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of Sec. 31, T.13N., R.20E., bears N. 61° 28' 20" W., 5938 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mack Land and Cattle Company, Inc.
Post-office address: Minden, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 4.68 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1376.4 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 20, 1974

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table listing land parcels with acreage and section/township/range information. Total: 344.1 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total annual duty of water from any and all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre annually.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
