CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Zenobia Creek (aka Zenovia Creek, aka Savonia Creek) through ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 1, Sec. 19, T.47N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 19 bears N. 7° 15' W. a distance of 177.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now, KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.
