CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kay L. Adams has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 2, T22S, R61E MDB&M or at a point from which the Center 1/4 corner of said Sec. 2 bears S68°22'08"W a distance of 1493.8 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.025 cfs but not to exceed 10.0 acre feet per annum  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

\* Date of priority of appropriation August 4, 1952

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:  
1.5 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 2, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.  
0.5 " " " SW 1/4 NE 1/4 " " " " "  
2.0 total acres

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre feet per acre per annum from all sources.

\* This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 14469 hence the date of priority of this certificate remains the same as Permit 14469.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
