CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well 3) through pipeline and pond for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 26, T.28N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 32, T.28N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M. bears S.65°45'13"E. a distance of 18,681.99 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 1.114 cfs but not to exceed 57.6 million gallons annually  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation August 7, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is conveyed through 1400 feet of 8 inch pipeline to a 1,000,000 gallon storage pond thence by pipelines to the mining and milling operation located within the NE 1/4, N 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 26 and NW 1/4, N 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 25, T.28N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
