CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Norman H. Hill has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Garden Creek Spring through pump and pipelines for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T.9N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., from which the NW corner of said Section 25 bears N. 37° 32' W., a distance of 1060 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Norman H. and Eleanor A. Hill

Post-office address Smith, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.75 cfs but not to exceed 48 acre-feet per year

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 13, 1968

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

12.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 25, T.9N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
