CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Davis Spring through a pipeline and trough for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 3, T.33N., R.61E. MDB&M, at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 3 bears S. 80° 55' 24" E., a distance of 2,738.87 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows

Amount of appropriation 0.0023 cfs or sufficient amount to water 75 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 1, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from Davis Spring through a hose pipeline to a watering trough located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 3, T.33N., R.61E. MDB&M for watering 75 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
