CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rattlesnake Creek, Upper Ditch through diversion into ditch for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 27, T.34N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., at a point from which the SW corner of Section 26, T.34N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 30°56'17"E., a distance of 2,230.04 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total annual duty of water from any and all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre annually.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
