CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. W. Eitel (rancher) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of Section 1, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., bears N.18°44'30"E., a distance of 5328.50 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 4.5 cfs but not to exceed 1064.0 acre feet per season
Period of use, from March 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 9, 1967

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 10 columns: Acres, SW 1/4, NE 1/4, Section, T., R., M.D.B.&M. Includes rows for 6 acres in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M. and a total of 266 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total seasonal duty of water from any and all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
