CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert C. Downer, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pine Creek through pond, pump and pipelines for mining, milling and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 32, T.10N., R.26E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 32 bears West a distance of 1,190.82 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.5 cfs but not to exceed 2.5 m.g.a.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 5, 1969

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is collected from the creek in a bulldozer cut pond thence pumped to the mining and milling machinery through flexible conduits all located within SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 32, T.10N., R.26E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
