

THE STATE OF NEVADA  
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, David J. Krohn (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 14, T.18S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 14 bears N. 68° 21' 28" W. a distance of 1255.06 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator U. S. Lime Division, The Flintkote Company  
Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.22 c.f.s. but not to exceed 49.0 million gallons per annum  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
\*Date of priority of appropriation July 24, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed in the well thence conveyed via 4" pvc pipe 13,700 feet to a 23,000 gallon storage tank. The water is used principally for dust control within portions of Sections 14, 22, 23, 26, 27, 34, and 35, T.18S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 24015 hence the date of priority of this certificate remains the same as Permit 24015.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
