 CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well #8) through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 16 T.40N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 15, T.40N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 68°36'45"E. a distance of 11,059.88 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

347.4 Total Acreage

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre annually from any and/or all sources.
