CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and stock trough for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 28, T.35N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 28 bears S.63°29'18"E. a distance of 1.010.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Vernon and Joan Westwood
Post-office address: Wells, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0125 cfs or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 100 horses
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 26, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is pumped by a windmill into a 24" x 40' tank thence into a 10' by 24" stock trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 300 head of cattle and 100 head of horses.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
