CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Fern J. Barnes (secretary) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 22, T.29N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 23, T.29N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M. bears N.67°15'E. a distance of 6,930.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1.84 cfs but not to exceed 275.40 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from May 1st to September 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 26, 1974

Table with 10 columns: Description of land to which the water is appurtenant, and 9 columns of acreage values. Total: 68.85 acres total.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
