CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 1, T.47N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 1 bears S. 65° 58' W. a distance of 1,435.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.085 cfs but not to exceed 5.48 mga

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 12, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is produced from a drilled well thence pumped through a 2" and 3/4" distribution system to a casino, airport, 65 unit motel, swimming pool and lawns all located within the SW 1/4 Section 1 and NW 1/4 Section 12, T.47N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for commercial and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

* The total duty of water under this certificate and certificates under Permits 25430 and 25431 shall not exceed 5.48 m.g.a.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
