

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Vermont Ashdown, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T.8N., R.70E., M.D.P.&M. or at a point from which Mile Post 193, Nevada-Utah line, bears S. 85°46'E. a distance of 19,540.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Sidney Ashdown and Orson D. Tait

Post-office address Cedar City, Utah

Amount of appropriation 0.0171 cfs or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 1,250 head of sheep.

Period of use, from November 1st to April 30th of 1975 year

Date of priority of appropriation April 17, 1936

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is pumped from the well into a 5,000 gallon holding tank thence into two small watering troughs all located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 300 head of cattle and 1,250 head of sheep.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
