CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert Dorsa, Manager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through diversion box, pipeline and tanks for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 6, T.32N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 6 bears N. 17° 22' 38" W. a distance of 3,389.21 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.026 cfs or sufficient to water 825 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 19, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected in a diversion box at the spring thence conveyed by 1700 feet of 2 inch and 1700 feet of 1 1/2 inch PVC pipe to an 8 feet diameter and a 9 feet diameter stock tank located within the NE 1/4 Section 1, T.32N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used to water 825 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
