CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. S. Horton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 27, T.2N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 24, T.2N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 61° 47' E. a distance of 16,400.73 feet situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.5 cfs but not to exceed 117.95 m.g.a.  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

\* Date of priority of appropriation February 7, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is produced from the well thence conveyed by pipeline to a tank in the W 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 29, T.2N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M. thence to the place of use located within the W 1/2 SE 1/4 of said Section 29, T.2N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for mining and milling purposes.

\* This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 23674 hence the priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 23674.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
