CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank G. Arcularius has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rye Patch Channel through stream channel for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 31, T.4N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 31 bears S 81° E a distance of 655.0 feet

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada. Sec 72, Ch. 140, Statutes of 1913 Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS-533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0625 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from November 1st to July 1st of following year
Date of priority of appropriation November 12, 1926

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water flows along the stream channel from the point of diversion through the NW 1/4 Section 5, T.3N., R.44E., and 2,000 head of cattle water along the length of the channel.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
