CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Stephen F. Turner (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump & distribution system for commercial & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 26, T24S R58E, MDB&M or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 26 bears N 80° 31' 30" E a distance of 1,258.9 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, that the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Clark County School District

Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.03 c.f.s. but not to exceed 2.36 m.g. per annum

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 27, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed in the well and pumped to a 120 gallon pressure tank thence conveyed via a distribution system to a school located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
