CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clinton E. Stay, Ass't City Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T.20S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 5 bears S. 88° 45' 32" W. a distance of 2,335.24 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator City of North Las Vegas

Post-office address City of North Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1.0 m.g.a.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation March 22, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from the well thence conveyed by pipeline distribution system to the North Las Vegas service district where it is used for municipal purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 13331, Certificate 5027, hence the priority of appropriation remains the same as Permit 13331.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
