CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Creek and Tributaries through unnamed small dam and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 30, T.44N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 30, bears S.60°30' E., 3590 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Willow Creek Ranch, Inc.
Post-office address: Orovada, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 2.2 cfs but not to exceed 553.72 acre feet per year
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 6, 1972

Table with 10 columns: Description of land to which water is appurtenant, and 9 columns of acreage data. Total Acres: 138.43

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water from any and/or all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre annually.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
