CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Fred Walther has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Colony Drainage Canal through headgate ditches and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 22, T12N, R23E, MDB&M or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner Section 23, T12N, R23E MDB&M bears S. 45° 15' E., a distance of 3,728.0 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 3.0 cfs but not to exceed 220.0 acre feet per season  
Period of use, from March 1st to October 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation March 9, 1970

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:  
25.0 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 22, T12N, R23E, MDB&M  
30.0 " " " SW 1/4 NW 1/4 " 23 " " "  
55.0 Total Acres

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
