CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clyde A. Hill has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an un-named spring through an earthen storage tank for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 20, T.44N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 20 Bears S. 47° 39' 25" W., 1,603.18 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Clyde A. Hill
Post-office address: Cedarville, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.0031 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 100 head of cattle.
Period of use, from: April 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 16, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected at the spring in an existing earthen tank of approximately 10,098 gallons capacity where it is used to water 100 head of cattle and located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, T.44N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
