CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr. (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T.41N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Section 33 T.41N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 16° 16' 36" W., a distance of 9,133.59 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 4.615 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1851.84 acre feet per season
Period of use, from March 15th to November 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 29, 1963

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.6 acre feet per acre per season from all sources. This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 25142 which in turn changes the point of diversion of Permit 21669; hence the date of priority of this certificate remains the same as Permit 21669.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
