CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, David C. Arnold, Vice President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Townsite Spring through gravel catchment, small dam and plastic pipeline for mining purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 14, T.6N., R.49 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 24, T.6N., R.49 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 87° 57' 24" E., 9244.73 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0267 c.f.s., but not to exceed 6.3 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 6, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is diverted from the spring directly into a reinforced concrete dam (dimensions 10' x 3' x 6") entrenched in bedrock, thence through a 2" I.D. plastic pipeline 4000' to a 55,000 gallon storage tank in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 23, T.6N., R.49 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M., thence piped 5200 feet to the place of use in the Tybo townsite located in the N 1/2 NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24, T.6N., R.49 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for mining purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
