CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, David C. Arnold, Vice President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Spring through a gravel catchment, small dam and plastic pipeline for mining purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 23, T.6N., R.49 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 24 T.6N., R.49 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 74° 34' 26" E., 6949.96 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 6, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is diverted from the spring directly into a reinforced concrete dam (dimensions 8' x 3' x 6") entrenched in bedrock, thence through 2" I.D. plastic pipe 1600 feet to a 55,000 gallon tank located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 23, T.6N., R.49 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M., thence 5200 feet to the place of use at the Tybo townsite located in the N 1/2 NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 24, T.6N., R.49 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for mining purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
