CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. Wells O'Brien, President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 5, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 5 bears N. 66° 17' 59" E., a distance of 2969.86 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Palomino Valley Water Co.

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.5 c.f.s., but not to exceed 242.92 acre feet per season

Period of use, from March 1 to October 31 of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation May 23, 1967

Description of the land to which the water is appurtenant:

40.0 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 4, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

26.6 " " " NW 1/4 SE 1/4 " " " " " "

66.6 Total acres

* This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 23888, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as that of Permit 23888.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water from any and/or all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre seasonally.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
