CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace E. Farr, permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 2, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 2 bears N. 41° 35' E., a distance of 1335.5 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Wallace E. and Marjory R. Farr

Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.03125 c.f.s., not to exceed 12.5 ac.-ft. per annum

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation August 4, 1952

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

2.5 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 2, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 14469, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as that of Permit 14469.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
