CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edna Timmons, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through a pipeline for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 20, T.39N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 20 bears S. 41° 23' 30" E., 3219.23 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Wilbur V. Timmons, Edna G. Timmons, Joseph L. Baker, Donald Swindlehurst and Loretta Pullen

Post-office address: Golconda, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.0089 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.365 m.g.a.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: May 25, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is collected in a headbox and piped from the spring to a concrete 2,000 gallon storage tank, thence through a 1 1/2" pipe to a single dwelling located in portions of the E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 20, T.39N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
