CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Spring through a gravel packed diversion and pipe for stock water purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 7, T. 36N., R. 46E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 7, bears S. 44° 09' E., a distance of 4575 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator The 25 Corporation, Inc.
Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0327 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 1500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 15, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed at the spring by means of a gravel filled diversion box, thence piped through a 2" plastic pipe to four 8' diameter x 2' high watering troughs located in the same 40 acre subdivision as the point of diversion for watering 1500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
