CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joe B. Fallini has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bucks Water, an underground tunnel through a pipeline and troughs for stock water purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 9, T. 1S., R. 54E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 9, bears S. 27° 30' W., 148 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe B., Helen Fallini & Joe B. Fallini Jr.

Post-office address: Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.0028 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 150 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: March 6, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is collected in the underground tunnel at the point of diversion and piped 7,300 + feet through a 1" plastic pipeline to an oval watering trough 8' x 2', then to a rectangular trough 14' x 2' x 16", then to an earth reservoir 40' x 20' x 1 1/2' all in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 7, T. 1S., R. 54E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used to water 150 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
