CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 3 T.35N., R.35E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Sec. 34 T.36N., R.35E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 16° 03' 49" W, 2,129.50 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator. Bell Telephone Co. of Nevada
Post-office address. Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation. 0.0282 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.0442 m.g. annually
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation. May 25, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is appropriated through a 6" well and submersible pump and is routed throughout the "Pronto Power Station" through a pipe pressure system where it is used for washroom and toilet facilities located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
