CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, ditch & stock water pond for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 1, Sec. 20, T.35N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 20 bears N. 6° 16' W., 835.0 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 800 head of cattle  
Period of use, from March 1 to October 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation August 8, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
The water is appropriated from the well, thence flows in an open ditch approximately 500 feet to a 0.5 acre-foot pond located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 24, T.35N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used to water 800 cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
