CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. H. Maness, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, pipeline and stock troughs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 23, T.45N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 23 bears N. 87° 41' 46" W., 1,400 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.1248 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 4,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 7, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is recovered from the well and pumped through approximately 2,500' of underground pipe to 15 watering troughs located in the feed lot in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 23, T.45N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for the watering of 4,000 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
